6. **GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS:**

- a. **Assistant Lecturer:** Applicants for the post of Assistant Lecturer must possess a minimum GPA of 4.0 or a B+ average at Master's degree level and an undergraduate degree with an overall GPA of 3.8 or higher from an internationally reputable higher learning institution. They must be potentially good academically.
- b. **Tutorial Assistant:** Applicants for the post of Tutorial Assistant must possess a Bachelor degree with a minimum GPA of 3.8 from an internationally reputable higher learning institution.

7. **MAIN DUTIES:**

- a. **Assistant Lecturer:**
  - i. Carrying out lectures, seminars, tutorials and practicals for undergraduate programmes
  - ii. Setting, invigilating and marking undergraduate examinations
  - iii. Assisting senior staff in lectures, seminars, tutorials, and practicals for postgraduate programmes
  - iv. Supervising projects and practical training for undergraduate students
  - v. Conducting research and publishing results;
  - vi. Carrying out consultancy and public service
  - vii. Undergoing postgraduate training to PhD level
  - viii. Participating in relevant workshops and conferences; and
  - ix. Performing any other relevant duties assigned by one's superior
- b. **Tutorial Assistant:**
  - i. Under-studying senior members of academic staff by attending their lectures seminars, tutorials and practicals
  - ii. Carrying out seminars, tutorials and practicals
  - iii. Assisting in research, consultancy and public service
  - iv. Performing any other relevant duties assigned by one's superior; and
  - v. Undergoing postgraduate training for the master's degree

- b. Applicants must have National Identification numbers from the National Identification Authority (NIDA).
